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<sup>\*\*</sup> The permit may only be granted for one a year; it cannot be extended and additional permits may not be issued after the one-year has been exhausted. The permit will only be issued for authorized setting(s), as defined in Education Law and Commissioner's Regulations.

<sup>\*\*\*</sup> The 36-month experience requirement cannot be reduced and other direct activities may not substitute for supervised experience in diagnosis & psychotherapy. An applicant who has not met the experience requirement in another jurisdiction must apply for licensure as a LMSW in New York and meet all requirements (see chart) in order to practice clinical social work under supervision in New York sufficient to meet the requirements.

<sup>\*\*\*\*</sup> If you passed the examination in another jurisdiction, you must request a score transfer from ASWB; scores submitted by applicants or jurisdictions are not acceptable. New York will not accept examinations given under non-standard conditions (e.g., ESL arrangements for extra time or translating dictionary); such applicants will have to take the exam under standard conditions.
